## Correct School Shoes

At Calderwood Christian School we are concerned about the safety of our students. Many shoes available for sale do not provide adequate foot protection and are not appropriate for certain subjects like science and technical classes. Your child is wearing their school shoes almost every school day, so it is worthwhile investing in a quality pair that meets our uniform policy guidelines. Parents of students wearing incorrect footwear will be contacted.

The school shoe must be sturdy, waterproof and offer full coverage of the foot. Shoes with Velcro straps are permitted for Kindergarten – Year 2 only. Below are examples of correct school shoes. ## Correct Sports Shoes

Sports shoes must be a runner or cross-trainer, specifically designed for physical activity. They may be of any colour and can have up to 50% fluorescent colouring. Casual, flat soled or skater shoes are not acceptable.
